CAMP SITE REGULATIONS

Please see the camping field guidelines below:

- The Terms and Conditions between you and RBF FESTIVALS LTD are incorporated into and should be read
 together with the Cambridge Rock Festival ticket terms and conditions, please click this link:
 www.cambridgerockfestival.co.uk/terms-conditions/ to review.
- 2. If you provide RBF FESTIVALS LTD with incorrect, incomplete or false information in relation to the purchase or use of a Camping ticket, RBF FESTIVALS LTD reserves the right to cancel your Camping Ticket.
- 3. A Camping Ticket gives you access to one Pitch measuring approximately 8m by 8m within the Camping Site Area.
- 4. One camping ticket is required per Pitch but every occupant staying on the Pitch (whether in a vehicle or a tent) must be in possession of a valid Festival Ticket.
- 5. The camping ticket purchased must match the type of vehicle occupying the pitch. If, after you have purchased a ticket, you need to change the type of accommodation please email emmat.crf@gmail.com
- 6. Only one camping vehicle/tent will be admitted to the Camping Site per pitch
- 7. Cars are only permitted to stay on your Pitch if the both the vehicle and the tent/caravan fit within the Pitch.

 If this is not the case, you will be required to park your car in the day car park.
- 8. You will be permitted to erect: an awning if it fits within the camping pitch but please be aware that this may result in your car needing to be parked in the Day car park AND b. one tent. provided that these items fit within your Pitch alongside your camping vehicle.
- 9. All Tents/Caravans/Motorhomes should be parked on the left hand side of the pitch to ensure the maximum distance between living accommodation.
- 10. Gas cylinders must be correctly fitted with an approved regulator. Please also see the terms and conditions on your festival tickets and the event website for information on permitted items.
- 11. Charcoal BBQs and fires are strictly prohibited. They are a major fire hazard and damage the site. All lamps with flames are prohibited. Gas BBQs are allowed but must be raised off the ground on a stable fireproof base
- 12. All vehicles and belongings must be removed from the site by 11am on Monday 4th August 2025. Any items or vehicles left on the Camp site will be removed and we reserve the right to charge any costs incurred to the customer.
- 13. Please be prepared to have your vehicle(s) searched on entry to the event site. The security staff may check for any items not permitted on site, as specified in the Terms and Conditions on weekend tickets. Security staff will confiscate any such items and may refuse entry to the site. The discretion and decision of the security team will be final.
